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J. REPORTS FROM ADMINISTRATION

1. Flood Recovery Update

Administration provided a verbal update on flood recovery efforts:

- \$6.2M has been approved through the provincial erosion control funding program.
- Administration is still waiting to hear results of the Town's Disaster Relief Program (DRP) application.
- Nine bids were received in response to the tender for Cougar Creek mitigation. The contract will be awarded within the next week or so. Administration is actively pursuing closure of DRP application so work can begin as soon as possible.
- A local expert is leading "after action reviews," debriefs with the various departments and outside companies involved in the disaster response.
- Administration met with Pigeon Creek stakeholders, to recommend that they
 carry out a detailed risk assessment and mitigation prior to any development
 in this area. Administration will submit a technical memo to the MD of
 Bighorn, however will not take the lead on any mitigation projects.
