

2014 Municipal Census



The 2014 Canmore municipal census date was May 20.

Enumeration was carried out between May 20 and July 30, 2014. The Minister of Municipal Affairs granted special permission to extend Canmore's enumeration period past the June 30 deadline set out in the legislation.

2014 census information was collected using an on-line program developed by the City of Airdrie. Residents were able to complete the survey on-line using Personal Identification Numbers (PINs). Enumerators collected information door-to-door from residents who did not complete the survey on-line. The enumerators used tablets, which fed the data collected directly to the on-line system. Where residents could not be contacted personally, enumerators attempted to collect data from third parties such as neighbours and property managers.

Count of the Non-Permanent Population

A non-permanent resident is a person who occasionally resides in Canmore but whose permanent address is elsewhere.

While the count of the non-permanent population is not eligible for submission to the Province, the information is valuable to us for planning local programs and services.

Non-permanent residents completed the census using the same methodology as permanent residents. They could fill out the survey on-line or with an enumerator. Where non-permanent residents could not be contacted personally, enumerators attempted to collect data from third parties such as neighbours and property managers.

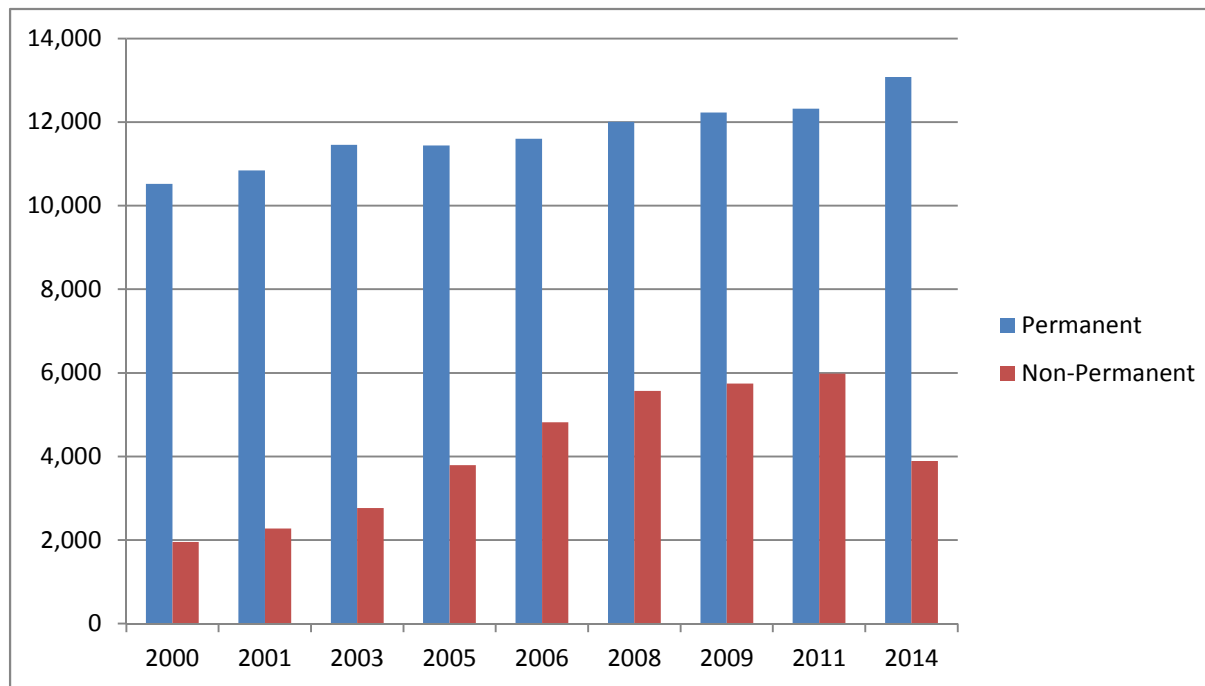

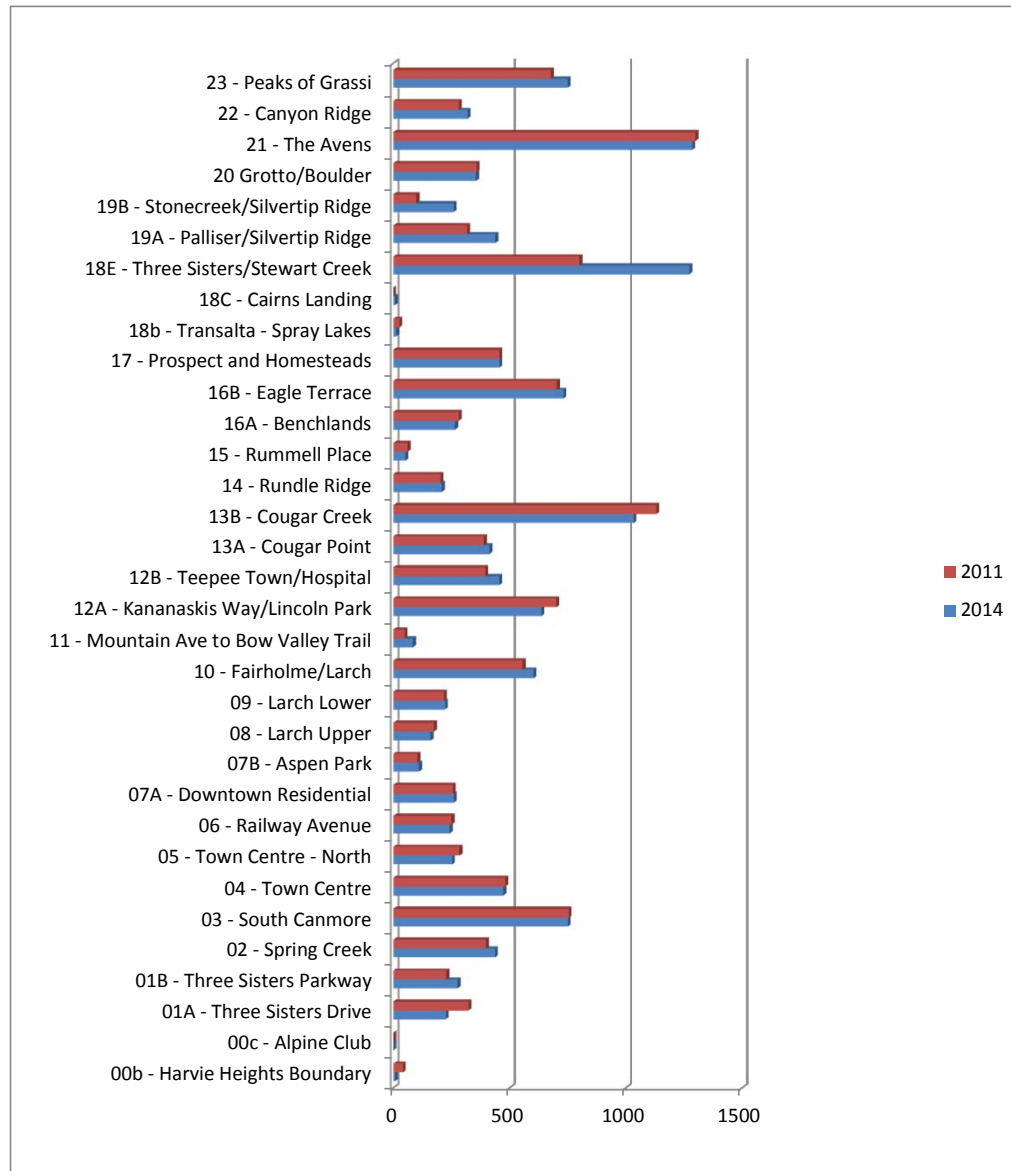

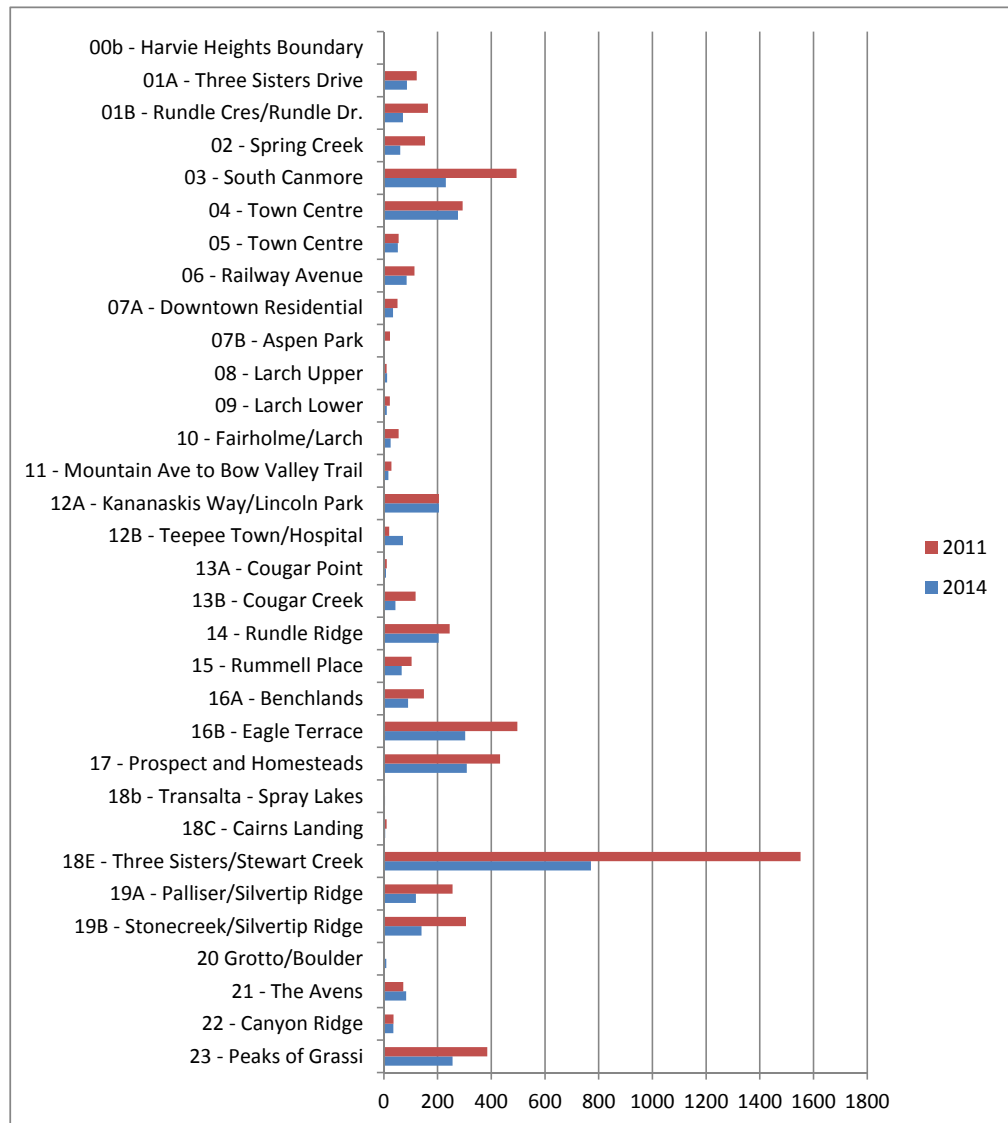
