

WE HAVE ILLUSTRATED THE BANK LOCATION AS SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 8, 2022, HOWEVER FOR THIS TO BECOME THE LEGALLY ACCEPTED BANK LOCATION, THE WATER BOUNDARIES UNIT OF ALBERTA WOULD NEED TO BE ENGAGED TO COMPLETE A "CHANGE IN NATURAL BOUNDARY" APPLICATION AND SUBSEQUENT REGISTRATION AT LTO. REVIEWING AERIAL IMAGERY SINCE THE ORIGINAL \sim 1890'S TOWNSHIP PLAN THERE HAVE BEEN MANMADE INTERFERENCES THAT HAVE SUBSTANTIALLY IMPACTED THE WATERCOURSE. THIS HOWEVER IS SOMEWHAT INCONSEQUENTIAL ALONG THE BANK IN QUESTION BECAUSE THE WATERWAY AND LAND TO THE NORTH OF IT IS ALL OWNED BY THE PROVINCE (CROWN). A DISPOSITION MAY BE REQUIRED TO FACILITATE THE NEW PATHWAYS WITHIN CROWN LAND, AND AS PART OF THAT DISPOSITION THE NECESSARY SURVEY MAY BE UNDERTOOK TO UPDATE THE LOCATION OF THE NATURAL BOUNDARY (BED AND SHORE) TO REFLECT ITS CURRENT LOCATION, SIMILAR TO WHAT WAS DONE ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE BOW RIVER PATHWAY CANMORE
