DETAILS OF ADDENDUM:

1. Question – Article 1.4.1.3 of the RFQ mentions Lux – Commercial 16 or 18-guage flush hollow metal, Lux – Commercial 18 gauge 6-panel hollow metal OR approved equivalent. It seems Lux does not manufacture commercial doors, is there another preferred brand?

Answer: Delete reference to the brand name Lux. The requirement is for an exterior 16 or 18-gauge commercial hollow metal door.

Answer: Delete "Lux – Commercial 18 gauge 6-panel hollow metal OR approved equivalent."

2. Question – Will the Town entertain a cash allowance for the sheathing as the quantity is not known?

Answer: No. There sufficient information in the RFQ to allow for a fixed price. .

3. Question – Has the floor materials assembly requiring removal been tested for asbestos?

Answer: There are areas of flooring that had not been tested for asbestos. We have initiated a new test of this flooring with results expected on February 5th. A one-week extension to the question period and the closing date is being issued as a part of this Addendum 03.

4. Has the remainder of the work areas been tested for asbestos?

Answer: Yes. There is no known asbestos in the work areas covered by this RFQ aside from as mentioned in answer 3 above.

5. Question – With the Town acting as the GC, does section 2.13.1 of the RFQ still apply?

Answer: Yes, under this RFQ the Town will issue a letter of award and a CCDC 2 contract to all contractor(s) directly employed by the Town.

6. Question – Will the Town accept a quotation from a bidder acting as a GC?

Answer: Yes. The Town is open to a GC bidding the work as well as individual trades bidding their own scope. The Town will consider which offers the best solution and value while evaluating the options available to the Town.
